## **5. CITIZEN ISSUES**

As such, the City Council can't take action on items raised during citizens issues at the same meeting but may request additional information or that the item be placed on a future agenda.

Jazmine Reece spoke about the issues her HOA at Harmony Place is having and asked for any help the City could give.

Mayor Westlund asked staff to give Council a update on what is going on and to look into if there is anything the City can do to help.

Mayor Westlund: Thank you for coming out for the meeting. It is nice seeing every seat filled.

We interviewed the candidates publicly and it was recorded. All the information i had prior to this meeting was available on the City's website at the same time it was available to me.
